POLICY STATEMENT

Applicants seeking admission to Faculty of Health programs who have attended but have not completed a professional health-related program, must meet admission requirements in the year of application, apply for admission by the application deadline, and provide supplementary information about the professional program in which the student was previously or currently registered.

PURPOSE OF POLICY

To inform applicants from professional health-related programs of the additional admissions documentation required for application.

PROCEDURES

1. Upon application, applicants who have attended but have not completed a professional health-related program, will receive a supplemental information package from Enrolment Services.
2. The completed supplemental information package must be completed and received by Enrolment Services by June 1 of the year of application.
3. The supplemental information package will be added to the applicable Admissions Committee meeting material and sent to the Dean or designate (Coordinator of the applicable program) for review and follow-up.
4. The Dean or designate will provide any additional information to the applicable Admissions Committee about the applicant as obtained from the Dean, Director, or Head of the professional health-related program in which the applicant was previously or currently registered.
5. The applicable Admissions Committee/Registrar's Office reserves the right to deny admission to Faculty of Health programs based on any supplementary information obtained.
