Course Cost: Basic Life Support Provider is \$84 (\$80 + \$4 GST),

Basic First Aid is \$126 (\$120 + \$6 GST), Intermediate First Aid is \$194.25 (\$185 + \$9.25 GST),
per person payable to UCN at time of registration.

Instructor Name: Alison Desjarlais (BLS), Kari Lentowicz (Basic and Intermediate First Aid)

Basic Life Support Provider Training (EXT.0965): This ½ day course is taught using face-to-face delivery of Heart & Stroke curriculum. This course focuses on what health care providers need to know to perform CPR and use an AED (defibrillator) in a variety of emergency situations.

Basic First Aid Training (EXT.0070): This 1-day course is taught using face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum. The primary focus is CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED (defibrillator), and emergency situations.

Intermediate First Aid Training (EXT.0158): This 2-day course is taught using face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum and includes CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED, with more thorough coverage of first aid situations.
