CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING ININIMOWIN PROGRAM

LOCATION: UCN Training Centre Otineka Mall, HWY#10 North, Opaskwayak Cree Nation (The Pas), Manitoba

REVISED DATES: December 13, 2022 to December 15, 2023

This will be a **hybrid** delivery of face to face and zoom training; i.e. 5 days of face to face learning in Opaskwayak Cree Nation (The Pas) plus 2 days zoom learning from your community. Face to face classes will be held Monday to Thursday 8:30am- 4:30pm daily, Friday 8:30am-11:30am (one full week per month). Zoom classes will be held immediately after face to face training Monday & Tuesday from 8:30am-4:30pm. As Covid-19 guidelines change students will be advised.

TUITION: \$7,830.56 (including textbooks)

Students will require a laptop with video and microphone and reliable internet for Zoom learning.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: This **part-time** certificate program is designed to prepare fluent Cree speakers to take on the role of immersion teachers. The program will especially benefit uncertified language teachers who desire formal qualification and certified teachers who wish to enhance Cree teaching practices. Completion of this program will lead to excellent employment opportunities in teaching Ininimowin (Cree).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: Regular student or Mature student | Demonstrated fluency in the Cree Language. A completed Application for First Nations Language Teacher's Fluency Certificate must be signed by their Education Authority | Criminal Record and Abuse Registry Checks

REVISED DEADLINES:

- **November 10, 2022:** Admission applications & high school transcripts. Mail post-secondary transcripts to UCN Enrolment Services, Box 3000, The Pas, MB R9A 1M7. Students that meet admission requirements will be sent an acceptance letter to pass onto sponsor.
- **November 18, 2022:** Deadline to send in Authorization to Invoice (ATI) form, Training Authorization Notification (TAN) Forms or confirmation of payment arrangements.
