CLASS 1 TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING

Mandatory Entry Level Training (M.E.L.T.)

Effective November 1, 2021, all students must be fully vaccinated to attend training. Proof of vaccination will be required. Masks will be mandatory.

Location: UCN Thompson Campus located at 55 UCN Drive, Thompson, MB.

Dates: March 28 to April 23, 2022

- ✓ Weeks 1 & 2 classroom: Monday to Friday 8:00am – 4:30pm (30-minute lunch break)
- ✓ Weeks 3 & 4 in-cab: Monday to Saturday part-time

Cost: \$9850 per student (Includes course materials plus 2 attempts at Manitoba Public Insurance road tests)

Description: The 121.5 hour M.E.L.T. Class 1 training (EXT.0250 TH31) consists of 40.5 hour of classroom training, 40 hours in-yard training and 41 hours of in cab training.

Prerequisites prior to acceptance: (Refer to info on next page)

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Hold a valid full Class 5 license (stage F)
- Class One Authorized Instruction Permit (Learners)
- Class One Authorized Air Brake Permit (Learners- have an “I” endorsement)
- Valid medical record on file with Manitoba Public Insurance
- Driver’s Abstract



Once the prerequisites have been met, UCN will issue a “reserved seat” letter that can be provided to sponsors. Upon successful completion of the training, students will be required to book their own road tests.

The registration fee must accompany the registration form in order for your seat to be held. Pay by cash, check, Purchase Order, ATI, TAN, MasterCard/Visa. Courses are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrolment.

Refund Policy: 100% refund will be issued if course is cancelled by UCN. If student wishes to withdraw, a refund will be issued providing the original receipt and voluntary withdrawal form are submitted to UCN 20 business days prior to first day of class.

CLASS 1 TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING

Mandatory Entry Level Training (M.E.L.T.) Prerequisite Information

Prerequisites required prior to acceptance:

1. **Minimum 18 years of age**
2. **Hold a valid full Class 5 licence (Stage F)**
 - a. A valid full class 5 driver's licence is needed (authorized instruction or learners permit is not acceptable)
3. **Knowledge tests/Authorized Instruction Permits (Learners):**
 - For a Class 1 licence and for airbrake knowledge tests, applicants must pass the knowledge test with Manitoba Public Insurance (MPI) for the class of licence they are applying for. This is not an open book test and cellular phones or electronic devices cannot be used during the test. The knowledge test charge is \$10 (subject to change) per test. Only one knowledge test per class of licence (Class 1 to 4) is allowed per day. You may repeat a Class 1 or Air Brake knowledge test on the next working day.

5. **Valid medical record on file with Manitoba Public Insurance**
 - A driver applying for Class 1 licence must file a mandatory [Medical Examination Report](#) with Manitoba Public Insurance (MPI). This report must be approved by [Driver Fitness](#) prior to obtaining your authorized instruction. Applicants are permitted to take the Class 1 knowledge test before the Medical Examination Report is approved. The medical report is valid for six months from the date your physician completes it. Your authorized instruction must be obtained within this six-month time frame.
