**TUITION:** \$6,495.00 per seat payable at time of registration

*The cost includes all course materials, and one attempt at the MPI tests (theory, airbrakes and road). Students will be required to complete a road test with MPI, once it's scheduled.*

**DESCRIPTION:** Class 3 Truck Driver Training (EXT.0221 SR.41) will prepare students for the theory and practical aspects of obtaining the Class 3 with air brakes endorsement from the Manitoba Motor Vehicle Branch. A Class 3 license permits the holder to operate trucks with more than two axles, but does not include semi-trailer trucks. Career paths could include dump truck, cement truck, vacuum truck, sewer truck and grain truck drivers.

Pre-requisites prior to acceptance include:

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Completed driver's medical
- Hold a valid Class 5F driver's license

Upon meeting the prerequisites, UCN will issue a seat confirmation letter than can be provided to your funder. Once payment arrangements are made, you will be fully accepted to the course.
