

# CLASS 3 A TRUCK DRIVER TRAINING

In partnership with Learn Right Driving School we are pleased to offer:

The **Class 3A Truck Driver Training program** (EXT.0221 TP10) allows the license holder to operate trucks with more than two axles or a truck with two axles towing a vehicle with a registered gross vehicle weight of more than 4,540 kgs (but does not include a semi-trailer truck). Career paths could include dump truck, cement truck, vacuum truck, sewer truck and grain truck drivers. Will prepare students for the theory and practical aspects of obtaining the Class 3 with air brakes endorsement.

- Week 1:** In-classroom learning for the Knowledge Test scheduled at the end of the first week.  
**Week 2:** In-classroom learning for the Airbrake Test scheduled at the end of the second week.  
**Weeks 3&4:** In-vehicle Driving for first group followed by Road Test after required hours completed.  
**Weeks 5&6:** In-vehicle Driving for second group followed by Road Test after required hours completed.

**Prerequisites required prior to acceptance:**

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Hold a valid full Class 5 license (stage F)
- Valid medical record on file with Manitoba Public Insurance

Once the prerequisites have been met, UCN will issue a "conditional acceptance" letter that can be provided to sponsors. Final acceptance will be verified when payment is confirmed.

**Location:** UCN Training Centre Otineka Mall, HWY#10 North, Opaskwayak Cree Nation (The Pas), Manitoba

**Dates:** July 17, 2023 to August 25, 2023

**Training Hours:** Monday to Friday 8:30pm – 4:30pm (Saturday training may be scheduled)

**Cost:** \$7,800.00 per student (Includes course materials plus one Manitoba Public Insurance (MPI) knowledge test, air brake test and road test) Note: testing dates may vary due to MPI scheduling.
