Basic (Emergency) First Aid: Using hands-on training and practice, this 1-day basic First Aid course will give you confidence to respond effectively in an emergency. You will learn lifesaving skills such as CPR/ AED and obstructed airway procedures to respond to adult, child and infant emergencies. You will also learn to recognize and respond to respiratory and circulatory emergencies including asthma, allergic reactions, heart attack, stroke, and bleeding.

Intermediate (Standard) First Aid: This 2-day intermediate First Aid course provides comprehensive training covering all aspects of First Aid, CPR and AED use. This course is for those who want an in-depth understanding of first aid. Whether you need training for employment or simply want to be prepared to respond to life-threatening emergencies, this course will give you the skills to act with confidence. It includes all of the content for Emergency First Aid as well as how to treat head/neck injuries, soft tissue and musco-skeletal injuries and medical emergencies.
