The Position: University College of the North requires an instructor to teach IDS.1003 Academic Research and Writing for the Year 1 Bachelor of Arts cohort on OCN in the evenings and on weekends on a stipendiary basis in term 20, 2021; September 2021-December 2021. This is a 3-credit hour course. Face to face or virtual delivery to be determined at time of hiring. Should an instructor not be from OCN/The Pas, delivery will be virtual.

Qualifications:

- The candidate must have coursework or a degree in rhetoric, composition, literature and/or English education specialty coursework.
- Experience teaching/tutoring English as an Alternative Language (EAL) and/or in development and first-year English composition
- Experience applying culturally relevant educational practices
- Experience teaching using blended delivery methods (e.g. D2L, Adobe, Zoom, F2F, other)
- Effective communication skills
- Effective interpersonal skills
- Strong self-management skills
- Excellent teamwork and time management skills
- Demonstrated ability to understand and to deal with cultural influences and issues specific to Indigenous learners and mature students in northern Manitoba
- Experience and/or knowledge and understanding of the Indigenous culture

Assets:

- The ability to speak an Aboriginal language
- PhD. In English preferred

Conditions of Employment:

- Candidates must be legally entitled to work in Canada

Applicants must provide a cover letter, résumé, transcripts, and references with their application.
Applicants must demonstrate on their résumé how they meet the qualifications.

Applicants are invited to indicate in their covering letter or resume if they are from any of the following groups: Indigenous people, persons with disabilities, visible minorities, or women and men in non-traditional roles.
