**The Position:** University College of the North Require instructor to teach SOC.1005 Introduction to Sociology in Term 30 from January 2022-April 2022 for the Year 1 Bachelor of Arts Cohort on OCN. This is a 3-credit course. Instruction will be in the evening and on weekends. Face to face or virtual delivery to be determined at time of hiring. Should an instructor not be from OCN/The Pas, delivery will be virtual.

- Experience applying culturally relevant educational practices
