DESCRIPTIONS:

Basic First Aid Blended: Half of the material is covered online with the practical portion completed in class for a half day with an instructor. This course is taught using online and face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum. The primary focus is CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED (defibrillator), and emergency situations.

Basic First Aid: This 1-day course is taught using face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum. The primary focus is CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED (defibrillator), and emergency situations.

Intermediate First Aid Blended: Half of the material is covered online with the practical portion completed in class for one full day with an instructor. This course is taught using online and face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum and includes CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED, with more thorough coverage of first aid situations.

Intermediate First Aid: This 2-day course is taught using face-to-face delivery of St. John Ambulance curriculum and includes CPR Level C (adult/infant/child), AED, with more thorough coverage of first aid situations.
