Instructor Development Program (EXT.1880 TP21) This program is for those who wish to become instructors with St. John Ambulance. The program includes in-class instruction and post-class development. The program consists of three modules. Following completion of the program, candidates then go through a period of co-teaching and monitoring, before being certified as a First Aid & CPR Instructor.

- ✓ **Entrance Requirements:** Must be at least 18 years of age; Must possess a valid Intermediate First Aid/CPR Level C/AED Certificate (issued within the last 6 months); Criminal Record & Child Abuse Registry Check
