COURSE DESCRIPTION: This is a provincially recognized food service safety course that provides the student with a greater understanding of the relationship between microbiology and food-borne illnesses. Students learn the proper techniques for preparing, servicing, purchasing, and storing food to ensure that it is safe to serve the public. This course also discusses topics in the area of how to properly clean and sanitize equipment that comes in contact with food, safe housekeeping, as well as insect and rodent control. Upon successful passing of examination, students will receive a certificate that is valid for 5 years.
