The **Heavy Equipment Operator Certificate Program** includes:

- ✓ 160 hrs. of practical equipment training experience on 6 pieces of heavy equipment. Equipment can vary and will include any combination of the following; Grader, Dozer, Rock Truck, Loader, Track Hoe, Skid Steer, Mini-Excavator, TLB.
- ✓ 80 hrs. of in-class Heavy Equipment Operator theory including Safety Training (CSTS, TDG, WHMIS, Ground Disturbance, Standard First Aid) as well as Waskawimakanwa Mecimwaci Isihtwawina (WMI)

### Admission Requirements:

- ✓ Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- ✓ Valid Class 5 driver's license
- ✓ Have a min. Grade 9 Reading, Writing and Comprehension skills
- ✓ Physically fit (able to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions)
- ✓ Must be committed to participating in all aspects of the training program
