University College of the North (UCN) is committed to building a workforce that is representative of the populations we serve. Applications are invited from individuals who have a demonstrated interest and ability to work with Indigenous learners and mature students.

The Position: Instructors are needed to teach IT courses and assist with work-integrated-learning (WIL) within the Information Technology Readiness North (InTeRN) project currently underway at The Pas Campus of UCN. Because of the nature of this project (shorter term (to be completed by July of 2022)), the diversity of subjects within the program, the centrality of WIL to learning, and the focus on Indigenous female students entering the IT sector, we wish to have multiple instructors interacting with the students and the program. Consequently, we wish to hire these instructors as casual employees so we can integrate them into the program at the appropriate time (subject matter) and place (WIL opportunity).

Qualifications:

- Current CompTIA A+ Certificate by successfully writing the CompTIA A+ 220-1101 exams or be able to do so by September 27, 2021
- Candidate must have completed the Cisco CCNA 1 instructor course or be currently enrolled in a Cisco CCNA instructor class
- Candidate must have a strong understanding of, and experience within, the IT industry, general world wide web functions, and industry standards
- Proven abilities in effective and culturally relevant communications
- Inter-personal skills
- Experience working with northern and Indigenous students and adult learners
- Experience and/or knowledge and understanding of Indigenous cultures

Assets:

- The ability to speak an Indigenous language
- Ability to work one on one with students should be proven
- Candidate should have classroom experience in a skills-based classroom environment.

Conditions of Employment:

- Candidates must be legally entitled to work in Canada
- As of November 1, 2021, all students, faculty, staff, and visitors must be vaccinated for Covid-19 if they intend to be physically present at a UCN facility.

Applicants are asked to provide a cover letter, resume and three letters of reference with their application. Applicants must demonstrate in their cover letter and their resume how they meet the qualifications.

Representative Workforce is a factor in the selection process. Preference will be given to Indigenous candidates. Applicants are invited to indicate in their cover letter or resume if they are from any of the following groups: Indigenous people, persons with disabilities, visible minorities, or women and men in non-traditional roles. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority
