### **Train Remotely – Attend **VIRTUAL** Classes with a Live Instructor**

Registered students will take this training from their home or workspace. Students will not be attending at one of our UCN campuses or Centres. #### **DESCRIPTION:**

These Train the Trainer courses are designed for individuals that have some basic understanding and knowledge of occupational health and safety in the workplace. Each course is one full day dedicated to instructional techniques. Completion of Train the Trainer courses demonstrates the student has acquired the knowledge about training course requirements, development, and presentation. Students will receive electronically all training materials upon successful completion of these courses.

# **Train the Trainer Course Descriptions**

## **Confined Space Train the Trainer (full day):**

The course will address the hazards associated with confined spaces and it will outline the duties and responsibilities of all members of a confined space entry team, emergency rescue procedures, and plan development. Upon completion of this course, participants will be capable of identifying and adapting to the hazards of confined spaces and be able to identify & define standards for safeguarding confined space entries. They will also be able to train this course internally within their workplaces.

## **Fall Protection Train the Trainer (full day):**

This course teaches participants how to exercise the hierarchy of controls including fall prevention, fall restraint, and fall arrest as each situation will be different when working at heights. Students will learn how to inspect fall protection equipment, how to don a harness. This course will begin teaching participants the same program a fall protection participant would learn to ensure potential trainers have a solid working knowledge of working at heights; this includes a written and practical skill assessment to validate training competencies.

## **Instructional Techniques Train the Trainer (full day):**

The course is also offered as a stand-alone course as it is designed to teach trainers how to facilitate safety training in their workplaces. The course is designed to help students gain the knowledge and skills necessary to conduct occupational safety and health training for their employer. Completion of Train the Trainer courses demonstrates the student has acquired the knowledge about training program requirements, development, and presentation.
