## Prerequisites prior to acceptance:

- ◆ Minimum 18 years of age
- ◆ Hold a valid Class 5 Stage F
- ◆ Class One Authorized Instruction Permit (Learners)
- ◆ Class One Authorized Air Brake Permit (Learners)
- ◆ Drivers Abstract

Each student will be given an entrance test and a short interview in order to be eligible for training. Upon meeting the prerequisites, UCN will issue an acceptance letter that can be taken to your funder.

**During the Covid 19 Pandemic all training dates below have been postponed until further notice. However, if interested, please call to have your name added to the list.**

**In partnership with First Class Training Centre Inc., this 244-hour course (EXT.0250) consists of 80 hours of classroom training, 40 hours of in yard training (which includes coupling/uncoupling, backing, pre-trip and air brake inspections), 60 hours of driving, and 60 hours of observing. It will be 2 students to 1 instructor ratio.**

**Dates:** 2 students per intake

- 1) June 25-August 7, 2020
- 2) August 10 –September 21, 2020
- 3) September 22 –November 3, 2020
- 4) November 4-December 16, 2020
- 5) December 17- February 1, 2021

**Tuition: \$8950.00** per student. The cost includes all course materials, and two MPI road tests totaling 4 hours of MPI road test time.

**Times:** Monday to Friday 8:00am-4:30pm (1/2 hour lunch)

**Deadline to Register and Pay:** two weeks prior to each intake date

The tuition fee must be paid in order for your seat to be held.

Courses are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrolment.
