Welder's Helper: EXT.0416

This course is intended to be an introduction to Welders Helper and will follow Manitoba Apprenticeship and Trade Welder Level 1.

Small Motor Repair: EXT.0259

This course is intended to be an Introduction to Small Motor Repair and will follow Manitoba Apprenticeship Marine and Outdoor Power Equipment Technician Level 1.

Topics that will be covered include:

- Trade Safety Awareness
- Communication and Computer Skills
- Lubrication, Fuel Systems and Batteries
- Engine Fundamental and Seasonal Preparation
- Power Transmission
- Troubleshooting

Students will repair and troubleshoot the following equipment:

- Snowmobiles
- Snow Blower
- Lawn Mower
- Outboard Motor
- Generator
