CAYC Manitoba Bursaries for Students in Early Years Education

In 2022 Bursary A is open to students who are in their final year of studies in Early Years Education or Early Childhood Education at a post-secondary institution in Manitoba in the **fall 2022**. The bursary is intended to support students with professional development activities (which could include attendance at workshops, conferences, purchase of books, materials, etc.) which will help to make them stronger, more knowledgeable and confident early years teachers.

***Bursary A** consists of five hundred dollars (\$ 500) and one year's membership to the Canadian Association for Young Children. The membership gives the individual two online journals and member rates to workshops and conferences. Up to two awards will be given in 2022.*

In 2022 Bursary B is open to students who are in their final year of studies in Early Years Education or Early Childhood Education at a post-secondary institution in Manitoba in **fall 2022** and who are taking classes on a part-time basis (minimum one class a term). The bursary is intended to support students with professional development activities (which could include attendance at workshops, conferences, purchase of books, materials, etc.) which will help to make them stronger, more knowledgeable and confident early years teachers.

***Bursary B** consists of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$ 250) and one year's membership to the Canadian Association for Young Children. The membership gives the individual two online journals and member rates to workshops and conferences. Up to two awards will be given in 2022.*

CRITERIA

Applicants should be enrolled in their final year of study in Early Years Education or Early Childhood Education in the Fall 2022 at a post-secondary institution in Manitoba including but not limited to: University of Manitoba, University of Winnipeg, Brandon University, St. Boniface College, Red River College, Assiniboine College and University College of the North.

To apply for this award an applicant must provide 3 items:

1. A current resume or curriculum vitae;
2. A cover letter indicating why he/she believes he/she should receive this bursary. The letter should include what the individual believes he/she offers to early years education and/or what his/her beliefs are about teaching and learning in the early years;
3. The names and contact information for two professors or instructors from his/her institution of study who are prepared to provide references if so requested. It is not necessary to send letters of reference with this application.

Completed applications must be received by May 31, 2022. Submissions must be complete with all items above and should be emailed to gorbertson@mts.net. If necessary they may be mailed to:
