The Manitoba Association of Mathematics Teachers Scholarship in Education is open to all students who are enrolled full-time or part-time in the Bachelor of Education program at University College of the North. Selection is based on academic standing (GPA of 2.5 or higher) and exemplary performance in student teaching in the field of Mathematics. Applicants are required to submit a completed UCN Manitoba Association of Mathematics Teachers Scholarship in Education application and provide a current copy of their university/college unofficial transcript(s) -if grades are unavailable have instructors sign their name by the WIP to confirm regular attendance. Applicants are also required to provide a letter of reference from their Field Placement Instructor/Coordinator or Cooperating Teacher that verifies their exemplary performance in student teaching in the field of mathematics. Deadline for application is **February 12, 2025 at 4:30 pm (CST)**; scholarship: 1; scholarship amount: \$500.
